HOW DOES BCAE WORK?

BCAE has identified several practices that help students learn and boost student success.

Learning communities

Students take all of their BCAE classes with the same group of students for the entire semester. After spending time together, students really get to know one another, and the friendships formed will help support them through the program and beyond. Many BCAE students report that their community of learners become family.

Interactive learning

If your idea of college is suffering through long, boring lectures, then think again. BCAE instructors are constantly engaging you, and asking you what you think. Many exercises are hands-on and interactive. BCAE is fun!

Integrated classes

BCAE classes are integrated. Behind the scenes, your BCAE instructors are meeting together and coordinating assignments.
