The BCAE Social Justice Research Fall Term cohort develops and enhances the academic experiences and leadership skills of first-time-in-college students through a social justice perspective and a team-based approach.

Students begin by identifying social justice issues affecting local and global communities.

After designing research frameworks, students collect, analyze, and interpret data. Upon completion of their projects, students present their research results to the College community and to the community at large.
